SUBJECT: update situation BRT Italian carriers

Dear Mr. Delmas

We would like to draw your attention on the situation of your Italian Subsidiary Company BRT spa, with reference to its Restructuring Plan, based on the substitution of historical transport suppliers with new ones.

Unfortunately, the negotiation between BRT and ASSOTIR has failed; in our opinion, because of the BRT determination to cancel almost all the contracts with the current transport suppliers in order to replace them with new ones.

While this operation seems to be formally flawless, we ask – and we intend to draw attention of the Representatives of National Institutions – how this conduct complies with reputational values of your Company, and, even more, which is the value added for Italian Small and Medium Sized Hauliers (the very same hauliers who contributed to the growth of BRT over time).

Given the situation, we have to inform you that we intend to, by the most appropriate initiatives, file a complaint about entrepreneurial conduct of BRT that, rather than offering growth opportunities, imposes the end of the commercial relationship, in other words, the end of several enterprises.

In addition to the above-mentioned initiatives, we will exert the right to implement self-defence actions at territorial level, just in the next weeks, without excluding legal actions, if needed.

Although we do not claim to be right, we kindly ask you to pay attention to the Italian situation.
